CALIFORNIA SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION LAW

Requirements For Kindergarten through Fifth Grade

The following is a summary for parent information:

POLIO: 4 Doses (3 Doses are acceptable if at least one dose was given after the

fourth birthday).

DTP/DT/TD/DTAP: 5 or more Doses — 4 doses meet requirements for 4-6 year olds if one

dose was given after the fourth birthday.

MMR: 2 Doses – second dose <u>must</u> be given before entering Kindergarten.

Hepetitis B: 3 Doses – now required for Kindergarten through fifth Grade – please

verify with your child's pediatrician.

Mantoux: T.B. test before entering Kindergarten.

Varicella: Beginning July 1, 2001, all students entering Kindergarten, First Grade

and Second Grade will need to present documentation of immunization or

immunity.

These immunizations must be completed, <u>and</u> proof of same received by the school, <u>NO LATER</u> <u>THAN AUGUST 11, 2014 NO GRACE PERIOD OF ATTENDANCE WILL BE ALLOWED</u>. Children <u>MUST</u> be protected before they enter school.

<u>Conditional Admission:</u> Children lacking one or more required vaccine doses, but not currently

due for a dose, may be admitted <u>on the condition</u> that they receive the remaining dose when it is due, and the school so informed. If the maximum time interval between doses has passed, the child must be excluded from school until the next immunization is obtained. It is recommended, however, that **ALL IMMUNIZATIONS BE DONE PRIOR**

TO ADMISSION.

The law allows permanent or temporary exemptions for medical reasons, or if immunizations are contrary to religious or personal beliefs of the parent or guardian. The parent must come to sign the waiver in the nurse's office.
